Why do we need training on suicide prevention with GLBTQ youth?

An increased number of risk factors and typically fewer protective factors place our gay, lesbian, bisexual, and transgendered, and questioning youth at higher risk for suicide and self-harm. If those who work with GLBTQ youth are aware of these issues they will be better prepared to offer services to these youth.
